# About SAACC

- SAACC is the South American Astronomy Coordination Committee
- SAACC is in its 9<sup>th</sup> year!
- SAACC is comprised of representatives from the various
  - Astronomy projects operating observatories in South America
  - The AmLight project, and operators of the research and education networks in South America and in the U.S.
- Jeff Kantor, IT Senior Manager for LSST, is the chair of the SAACC
- SAACC Goals
  - To provide input and advice to the AmLight Principal Investigator on program and network needs
  - To serve as a venue for coordinating the network needs of astronomical projects and institutions
    - to improve their resource planning and implementation of operational connections between these distant facilities and users in the continental US



# Partners and Goals

- AmLight interconnects the U.S. to key aggregation points in South and Central America (Brazil, Chile, Panama)
  - And, also West Africa at Cape Town, South Africa
- 5-year Cooperative Agreement with the U.S. National Science Foundation
- Cooperative and collaborative partnerships with ANSP, RNP, CLARA, REUNA, AURA, Vera Rubin Observatory, FIU, FLR, and Internet2
- Continue evolving a rational network infrastructure for research and education using both optical spectrum and leased capacity

- AmLight-ExP (OAC-1451018) is a project funded in part by the U.S. National Science Foundation (NSF) IRNC program
- Through the IRNC program and coordinated partnerships, NSF enables the growth and enrichment of a globally connected science community
- NSF announced the next IRNC solicitation in January 2020, NSF 20-535
- FIU and partners in AmLight responded with a new proposal
